In principle, exchange students can choose their courses not only from the degree programme they will be enrolled in but from all degree programmes and study years offered at the Faculty of Economics and Management.  For enrolment in courses of our Master's degree programmes, admission has to be requested for each course.
Credit system	ECTS – European Credit transfer system: credit points are indicated in the course list for each course  1 ECTS credit point is equal to 6 hours of teaching and a workload of 25 hours for an average student
Full time workload	20-30 ECTS / semester depending on the degree programme and study year
Exams/Grading system	Exams are graded on a scale from 1 to 30, with 18 being the minimum grade for passing and 30 as the maximum grade. A "cum laude" (c.l.) can be added to the maximum grade as a special distinction.
Languages of instruction	One third of the courses of each degree programme is taught in English, one third in Italian and one third in German (see course list for details, the language of instruction of each course can be different in the academic year 2015-16)

Accommodation assistance	The Free University of Bozen-Bolzano tries to accommodate all exchange students in student halls of residence (administered by the local government). Priority is given to NON-EU citizens because they need to have accommodation before their arrival, in order to obtain the student visa to enter Italy.  Application deadline: 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2015 (online application form) for the fall/winter (1 <sup>st</sup> ) semester, 30 <sup>th</sup> November 2015 for the spring/summer (2 <sup>nd</sup> ) semester  Students who prefer to look for a private accommodation can check offers on the university's online notice board <a href="http://accommodationunibz.blogspot.it/">http://accommodationunibz.blogspot.it/</a> or send us an advert which will be published on the notice board.	
Prices	Single room at student hall of residence: € 275 including expenses/month (+ returnable deposit: € 550). A full semester contract will be signed with the residence administration.  Private accommodation ranges from € 350 to € 500/month for a single room in a shared apartment (+ returnable deposit: 2-3 month rents)	
Move into residence	Fall/winter (1st) semester: from Wednesday, 30th September to Friday, 2nd October 2015 (to confirm) Spring/summer (2nd) semester: Monday, 29th February 2016 (to confirm)

- Entry Visa: the Italian Student Visa is free of charge and has to be requested at an Italian Consulate/Embassy (students have to be prepared to long processing times)
- Italian residence permit (to be requested once at place within 8 working days from the entrance in the Schengen Area): costs related to the issue  $\sim$   $\in$  180
- Food and personal items: ~ € 300/month
- Public transport (bus, train): several possibilities according to individual needs
- Textbooks: can be lent at our library, all teaching materials will be offered in digital format
